| <p>The SDA Union leaders are working on a letter to all churches and schools in Norway regarding the refugee crisis and will encourage all members to support ADRA financially as well as offering suggestions to activities and involvement with the refugees.</p> <p>At the ADRA office we are working on a plan on how we will support the members in activities and how we will take a coordinating role. Very few refugees from the current crisis have arrived in Norway so far, but it is expected that around 8000 will seek asylum here.</p> | <p>Main activities will be focused on fundraising in Norway as well as supporting local churches and members in various ways interact with refugees and offer support where needed.</p> <p>We are currently in contact with the social services specifically for refugees in Norway in the area where the office is to start negotiating on what ADRA Norway specifically can do.</p> <p>We have a reception area for refugees in our county and we are planning to work with them.</p> | <p>We are in dialogue with the Norwegian church Union to see if we can share the cost of a person specifically responsible for this work.</p> <p>We are attending relevant meetings on the crisis and will update where relevant.</p> | <p>Most likely the funds available for this will go through the Norwegian embassies in relevant countries. We do not expect specific funds to become available in Norway.</p> <p>We will however keep searching for opportunities.</p> |
